Cherry Buzz	Cherry	55	Indeterminate - loads of early, tasty, shiny, 1/2-3/4 " red globes with sweet flavor, crack resistant
Juliet	Cherry	60	Indeterminate - AAS winner, 1 oz. grape fruit, sweet & crack resistant
Little Bites	Cherry	65	Determinate - cute, compact plant for patios, and decks with great tasting tomatoes
Midnight Snack	Cherry	65-70	Indeterminate - AAS winner, red with a blush of glossy-black purple, good flavor
Pandorina	Cherry	72	Indeterminate - high-yielding, full flavor & disease resistant
Prairie Fire	Cherry	60-70	Semi-determinate - very sweet, grape-shaped 1" X 3" red flesh with gold striping
Sun Sugar	Cherry	62	Indeterminate - hybrid, sweeter than Sungold in taste tests, sweet, golden, yellow cherry
Sungold	Cherry	57	Indeterminate - early producer - sweet tart and amazing flavor - our most popular tomato
Super Sweet 100	Cherry	65	Indeterminate - hybrid tomato with 100 or more 1" sweet cherry fruit in clusters
Sweet Gold	Cherry	60	Indeterminate - vigorous vines, full, sweet flavor on jewel-toned golden fruit
Sweet Million	Cherry	65-75	Indeterminate - 1 to 1 1/2" fruit on grape-like clusters, great in salads, delicious flavor
Sweetie	Cherry	65	Indeterminate - clusters of 1"super sweet cherry fruit in clusters - good for patio containers
Uralskiy Ranniy	Cherry	51	Determinate - unique, super-early dwarf plants good for containers, 2-4 oz. red fruit
Valentine	Cherry	55	Indeterminate - massive early yields, deep-red color, unusually rich flavor, blight resistant
Yellow Pear	Cherry	70	Indeterminate - heirloom tomato, pear-shaped fruit, heavy production
Marriage Marzineria	Paste	70-75	Indeterminate -hybrid cross using San Marsano, high yields, early maturity, great flavor & meaty
Nova	Paste	65	Determinate - Roma type with meaty & red fruit on compact plants
Piennolo del Vesuvio	Paste	65-70	Indeterminate - fresh-tasting with an outstanding, balanced flavor, can be eaten raw or dried
Roma	Paste	75	Determinate - thick walled, meaty, perfect for sauces and salsa, 4' plant at maturity
San Marzano	Paste	80	Indeterminate - thick walled, few seeds with sweet full taste-chefs consider this the best Roma
Beaverlodge	Slicer	55	Determinate - rich & balanced flavor in plum shaped fruit, perfect for containers & hanging baskets
Better Boy	Slicer	75	Indeterminate - spectacular 1 pound, juicy, flavorful fruit with firm flesh
Big Beef	Slicer	73	Indeterminate - AAS Winner-flavorful beefsteak 10-14 oz. red, disease resistant fruit

Chianti Rose	Slicer	80	Indeterminate - 1 pound rose-colored fruit, will ripen in cooler fall temperatures
